

FASTEST STUDY FLOW SHEET FOR ED ADMINISTRATION

STROKE ALERT to ED identifying potential FASTEST patient

FASTEST study coordinators contact Pharmacy/APPs
Pharmacy/APPs (Mixing)
ED Pharmacy (513/688-5479): 0830-Midnight
APP's in Obs (513/688-5372): Midnight to 0830, weekends and as needed
Central Pharmacy - (513)584-1766 weekends
IDS - (513) 584-1766 7 AM - 4:30 M-F

Pharmacy/APPs Retrieve FASTEST Study Drug Kit From SRU Omnicell #1
Once logged into SRU OMNICELL Select patient/Stocked meds → Locate drug by typing in "IDS 2914-21 FASTEST KIT" → destock inventory → SRU Fridge will pop open → remove kit with lowest kit ID if multiple kits available (kit is in white box)

Let kit sit at room temperature for a minimum of 10 minutes prior to mixing; see video for details on how to mix:

Pharmacy/APPs will mix once ABC method is calculated by stroke team, patient enrolled, ICF obtained or EFIC utilized
(Everything needed to mix drug is in kit)

ED RNs will administer dose via IV over 2 minutes then flush line with NS
[Epic order will contain administration details. The order can be found under IDS 2914-21 FASTEST]

Discard supplies and leftover drug in sharps container; save KIT box and provide to study coordinator; **If drug is not administered study coordinator will keep drug KIT and return to IDS

Study coordinator will enter study kit label into WEBDCU in the Subject Enrollment Form within 6 hours of study drug administration
