



MSU Dispatch & Pre-Notification Process

- 1. Hamilton County Dispatch Center will co-dispatch MSU for suspected stroke along with local EMS department.
 - Tone to MSU crew
 - En route, MSU RN will notify UC Health's Air Care & Mobile Care Communications Center
- 2. ACMC Communications Center will notify UCMC Capacity Management
 - UCMC Capacity Management will then page UC Stroke Team physician via Halo
 - Faculty on call and stroke fellow will receive page
- 3. Patient will be evaluated by local EMS and MSU Crew
- 4. Once destination decision is made, two parallel lines of communication will happen simultaneously:
 - Nurse or paramedic on MSU will notify receiving hospital per usual EMS communication protocol
 - Stroke team physician will call UCMC's capacity management center to communicate patient disposition and will be connected to receiving hospital's receiving physician.
- 5. Images will be pushed to receiving hospital PACS from MSU.
